Dear All,

Citation index is an essential tool for research and Web of Science (WoS) databases are the most widely used and well-established citation index in the world. The Library has subscribed to them for quite a number of years.

In order to enable our users to carry out retrospective literature search, the Library has recently extended its coverage of the WoS citation indexes (SSCI, SCI-E, and A&HCI) to the year 1980. In addition, we have also added two new indexes -- **Conference Proceedings Citation Index- Science (CPCI-S)** and **Conference Proceedings Citation Index- Social Science & Humanities (CPCI-SSH)**.
